As part of the project, the international partners met during the kick-off meeting for the first time.

Dr. Zsolt Pásztor, the executive leader of the project introduced the Hungarian organisation, EUROPÉER Foundation's most notable goals and activities. Following this, our international partners introduced themselves: from Austria, representatives of Sietar Austria, Barbara Covarrubias and Daphne Demetrio; from Slovenia, Opro Institute's Tomaž Gerdina and Otto Gerdina; from Croatia, Cedex's Anton Florijan Barisic; from Slovakia, Selye János University's Dr. József Poór.

The executive showed a presentation to introduce the most notable parameters of the project and its milestones, its goals, and the problem itself that the project's target service aims to solve.

There was a discussion on the tasks the partner organisations would take up, and the specifications of taking part in professional events. Furthermore, the partner organisations' main to-dos were also determined.



Since the topic of the project – the service to be evaluated as part of the project dealing with education of the project-based lifestyle, and its related competence – is a very unique concept, first off, the concrete definitions needed to be finalised, and the contents of the term “Project Life Management” had to be determined. There

were mentions of domestic examples where people made different attempts of introducing project-based education.

Foreign partners were open and interested in the various routes of opportunities regarding the introduction of project-based life management and education, and saw very high potential in the area for their own homelands' research.
