REPORT ON THE FIRST FIELDWORK

NAGYKANIZSA

The fieldwork was hosted by the IMRO-DDDK Nonprofit Co. Ltd., taking up headquarters in Nagykanizsa.

The organisation was established in 2009, currently working with 7 official employees. Their activities cover a wide range of tasks, including environmentally friendly perspective change in civilians and institutions, energetics consulting among civilians, to organising municipality projects. As part of their activities, they create studies and strategy guides, organise events, informal education and adult education, for both domestic and foreign demand.

IMRO conducts one of its activities relevant to the currently detailed fieldwork in Africa, Benin state. They offer aid to local people, mainly teachers and civilian organisations in conducting their efforts as efficiently as possible. As part of this, the assistance related to project management and the transfer of relevant knowledge and experiences also happens.

The EUROPÉER Foundation was partaking in the fieldwork together with the Romanian, Slovakian and Croatian partner organisations' representatives, and other interested parties.

At the start of the fieldwork, the representatives of the foundation offered a short overview on the project, and the PLM programme. This was followed by a short introduction to the participating members. Afterwards, IMRO's representative offered a detailed explanation on their services, and activities related to them. During the presentation, the representative detailed best practices and experiences in the field of advisory work.



As the most important experience, the representative named the fact that local conditions and already existing knowledge need to be taken very seriously into consideration, most notably for foreign work, as the area and its inhabitants is entirely different in social and business culture.

After the presentation, the participants held discussions on questions relating to their own work, focusing on how to use their new knowledge on their own fields, and how to integrate new experiences. During the discussion, the partners – in some cases, as part of smaller presentations – also offered their relevant experiences from their own countries.

The fieldwork offered us a great opportunity to further develop international relations, and to cooperate on the preparation of further projects down the line.
