REPORT ON THE FIRST WORKSHOP

The project's first workshop was organised a day after the kick-off meeting, as such, the representatives of the partner organisation had their opportunity to ask questions that they formed during the kick-off meeting regarding the contents of the project, and the professional execution.

The main goals of the workshop:

- matching interpretation of PLM's professional contents, and identical interpretation of project target goals among partners
- discussion on the professional activities according to the timetable
- detailed discussion on the tasks of the partner organisations.

representatives of the EUROPÉER Foundation introduced the PLM concept to the partners: They can use the project management concept / approach and tools in their activities related to private life.

The Project Life Management concept's initiators own rights to the term. Therefore, there were several examples introduced regarding the concept, the keywords, the related activities and such, in order to facilitate matching interpretation within the partner group.

During the second part of the workshop, the future activities were discussed and set in the timetable.

- National overview – background information on the PLM concept by nation. The partner organisations all had to create a 10-30 page overview regarding what the foreign experiences of project-based education, and project perspective's usage in private life in practice are in said country (with references and hyperlinks). This international experience and best practice data will serve as the basis for the market research questionnaire that the domestic and foreign organisations chosen will fill out.

The questionnaire will be structured by the EUROPÉER Foundation, and translated to several languages. The task of partners is to evaluate the questionnaire, fix it if necessary, and have at least 100 relevant personnel complete it in each country.

After the joint brainstorming, each partner understood that project-based life management and using project management techniques in our everyday lives helps us reach a high level of development, both for the labour market and work-life balance.
