Topics discussed, conclusions, results:

Topic 1: Usage of project management tools and methods in various life situations

Summary of the discussion:

- Introducing the project management knowledge areas and processes via the actualisation of a private life project.
- Removing emotions and emotional decision-making during the private life use of the project perspective.

Conclusions:

- Knowledge areas and the process system of project management can be successfully adapted to any private life project; self-teaching, career building, love life project, marriage organising, having a child, raising a child, buying a home, building a home, healthy lifestyle, etc.
The various professional areas (construction projects, development projects, IT projects, logistics projects, environmental conservation projects, marketing projects) use project specifics that can be implemented successfully into our private life projects, as part of an ‘imaging’ of the professional project into private life.
- During decision-making, both rational and emotional perspectives have their own roles, using a PLM perspective for our everyday lives doesn’t mean we discard feelings or intuition, it just offers help for identifying when, in what life situations we can rely on intuition, and how much we can rely on feelings, when it’s time to analyse our decision

options and their consequences. By knowing and using the PLM perspective, we can learn aware decision-making and limited rationality's practical application.

Topic 2: Introduction of the Romanian research report

Summary of the discussion:

- How old are children when they first meet the definition of projects, and the elements of the project management toolset?
- Project management education on high school and university level.
- Project management methods in adult education and consulting.

Conclusions

- Children meet project management's definition at age 7-8, but often unintentionally, as part of a lecture, for example, personality development or consulting. In high school and university education, project management appears as an individual course, however, project management tools' and methods' usage in private life doesn't appear in educational policy.
- In adult education and consulting, there are several non-profit organisations and consulting firms, motivation trainers and coaches who help their clients in employing project management tools in their private lives, f.e. time management, communication management or financial awareness.
- During the processing of literature, Romanian authors' books, studies and papers in Romanian or English in project management, our partner organisations' representatives didn't find any literature approaching the usage of project management's toolset in private life from a scientific perspective.
