

## DETAILS OF THE FIFTH WORKSHOP OF 2019

### ROMANIA, TRANSYLVANIA MUSEUM FELLOWSHIP

The location of the workshop meeting of June, Kolozsvár was the auditorium of the Transylvania Museum Fellowship, Napoca st. 2. The workshop became the stage for exciting presentations, most notably about the opportunities of promoting project management knowledge to young adults, who are sucked into digitalisation, and about formal education framework for teaching project management knowledge in Romania.

The EUROPÉER Foundation's representative, Dr. Györgyi Lakatosné Szuhai held her presentation to raise awareness about how the current digitalised World completely absorbs youth, who think it perfectly natural that nowadays, they communicate with their friends and acquaintances. Connections and relations are shallow, knowledge and information worth something isn't transmitted, which is why systematic thought process, the usage of aware life management and such should be integrated into the traditional education. All in order to replace shallowness and surface-level thought with aware planning and organisation, and handling the online platform in a suitable manner. Furthermore, a strong extra of project management is the practicality of thought processes, which means an orientation towards practice, problem-determination and raising for the exactness of problem-solving.

Dr. Kinga Kerekes, the representative of the Romanian partner organisation also held a presentation on financial awareness. In her presentation, she stressed the actuality of the topic, the importance of families in the development of the child's financial awareness, the opportunities of developing financial awareness from "private funding", and the development of child financial awareness by age group. She stressed that financial attitudes are never too late to change, as with financial planning, we can close in on a lifestyle we wish to realise.

The workshop was visited by the representatives of the EUROPÉER Foundation, and the representatives of the Romanian partner organisation, furthermore, representatives of interested organisations. There were also local NGOs, family protection organisations, funds, fellowships, and the Kolozs County Youth Forum. They listened to the presentations, and held a discussion with moderator on the opportunities of employing the PLM methodology.

The workshop made it possible to create and strengthen international relations as well, building a cooperative network.
